On July 19, 2019 this Credit Union Manager and mother of one jumped out by Faith on a medical mission trip to Limon Honduras. **What started out as a “check” on my bucket list became an experience of a life time.**

I am not a doctor or nurse, so I was skeptical as to what use I would be. I quickly found out after our team treated 500 patients and filled over 1600 prescriptions in 5 days by 13 volunteers. Yes, there were three doctors, two nurse practitioners, two nurses and a pharmacist but I can assure you the other six of us worked just as hard.

The people of Honduras are gracious, humble and appreciative of anything you do. We worked 3 days in the clinic built by Dr. Henry Gibson and traveled to the small villages of Planes and Icoteas to remote clinics on the other two days.

**I took 15 baby blankets that I made and found homes for them all.** One of the doctors purchased a soccer ball and candy which was a huge hit with the kids. We had many requests for reading glasses and sun glasses and those will be on my list to take next year.
