RE: Coronavirus and Teams Traveling to Honduras

After reviewing the rising number of cases of COVID-19 both in the US and Honduras as well as the ongoing travel restrictions in Honduras, **the CHHF Board of Directors decided to suspend sending mission teams to Honduras for the remainder of 2020.** This unhappy decision was made with consideration for the health and well-being of our volunteer missionaries as well as that of our Honduran friends and neighbors.

The Board will be reviewing information available during the upcoming months and hopes to resume sending teams in early 2021.

In the meantime, efforts are underway to begin delivering essential medications to patients utilizing Honduran physicians and our Honduran staff. In addition, the development of a robust telemedicine program utilizing US doctors, nurse practitioners and physician assistants and our Honduran staff is well underway.

We are thankful for all of the people who have volunteered to go to Honduras this year as well as all of our donors who continue to support the work of CHHF. We will strive to keep up to date information on our website for both our volunteers and our donors. Please pray for our friends in Honduras as well as the ongoing work of CHHF.
